\*Students can elect to take up to three graduate courses (500-level) in place of the required undergraduate courses as part of the Baccalaureate to Master's Program.

Please note all ECC coursework must be completed before the student's final Lewis year.

### **Baccalaureate to Master's Program**

During Year 4, students have an opportunity to apply to the Baccalaureate to Master's program. Upon admission to the program, students may substitute up to three Criminal Justice graduate courses (see 500-level coursework) for three Paralegal Studies undergraduate courses. Tuition for the graduate coursework will be charged at the 3+1 tuition rate and financial aid will apply.

After conferral of the bachelor's degree if the student continues to the graduate program in Criminal Justice, s/he can complete the program in one year if the student completed three graduate courses as an undergraduate student. Additionally, the student will be given a 20% Frequent Flyer tuition discount.
